From the Pastor's Desk

“What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we looked upon and touched with our hands concerns the Word of life, for the life was made visible; we have seen it and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life that was with the Father and was made visible to us. What we have seen and heard we proclaim now to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; for our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. We are writing this so that our joy may be complete” (1 John 1-4)

Nothing we do as Catholics is more important than participating in the Sacrifice of the Mass. Since the celebration of the Eucharist is the action of the whole Church, everyone in the assembly has an individual right and duty to contribute their participation. Some of the faithful are called to serve God's people in a more particular way through one of the many liturgical ministries that have flourished in the Church since the Second Vatican Council. This diversity of roles, functions and ministries enriches our celebrations and assists us in our prayer. Serving in one of these ministries is both an honor and a responsibility, and those who commit to it need nurturing and support.

Extraordinary Ministers (EM) assist in the distribution of Communion. It is a ministry of service to the people of God. The US Conference of Catholic Bishops insists that all ministers of Holy Communion should show the greatest reverence for the MOST HOLY EUCHARIST by their demeanor, their attire, and the manner in which they handle the consecrated bread or wine. “What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we looked upon and touched with our hands concerns the Word of life, for the life was made visible”

Extraordinary Minister scheduling

The Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist (EM) schedule will be updated every two months. Schedules will be e-mailed, posted on the parish website and placed in the cry room. Schedules will only be mailed if you request.

If you are scheduled to serve and cannot, YOU are responsible for arranging for a substitute. The Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist Contact List will be attached to the schedule.

If you cannot serve on a regular basis and would like to be on the substitute roster, please let the EM Coordinator know. You must serve at least once a month to remain on the active roster.

Friday, September 29, at 6:30pm is the recertification of the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. The session will be held at the parish hall. Please come with your personal diary.

Communion by Intinction

No parishioner or visitor is permitted to dip the body of Christ into the Chalice containing the Blood of Christ. This action is called intinction. To put it in another way, communicants must not be permitted to intinct the host himself/herself in the chalice, nor to receive the intincted host in the hand. (Redemptionist Sacramentum 104)
