

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ Jesus,

We are surrounded by a "Cloud of Witnesses"!!! (<u>The Catholic Spirit</u> | Father Michael Van Sloun)

The communion of saints is a "communion," a union, a common bond, a profound connection, a great fellowship — shared among the "saints," the holy ones, the Christian faithful, those who are filled with grace, members of the one body with Christ as the head. The communion of saints is the Church" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, No. 946). 
