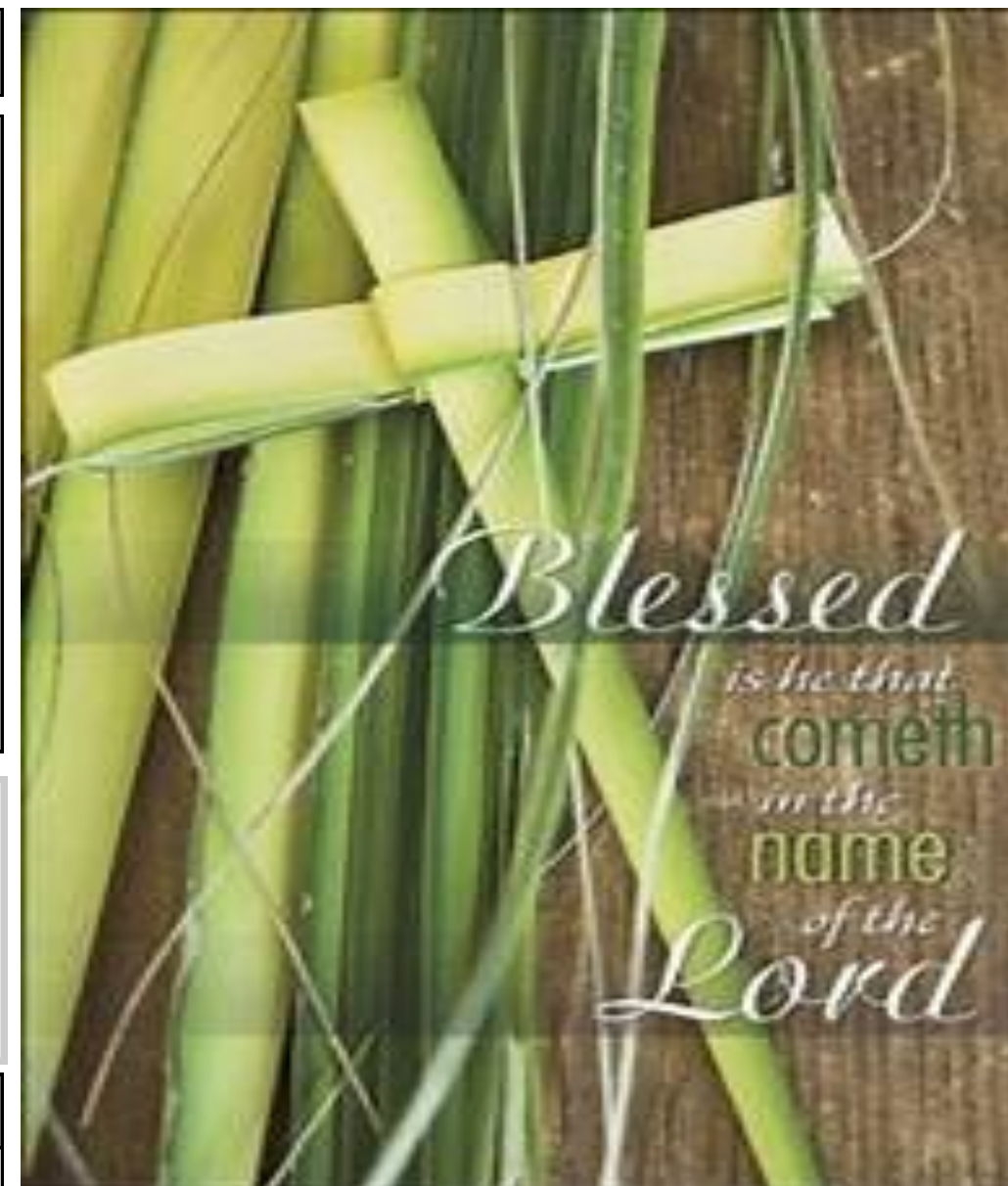

We, the parishioners of St. Paul, Onaway, open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, are dedicated to preserve, live and proclaim the Good News brought by Jesus. As a sacramental people, we are committed to welcome all into Christ's presence among us.

From the Pastor's Desk

Will we have Holy Week Liturgies with the people in our parishes?

Holy Week liturgies are to be celebrated with the seminarians and clergy of the parish household, a minimum

of liturgical ministers, and no assembly. One musician and one cantor only may assist with the music. One

altar server may assist but should not handle any of the vessels. Only the celebrant, concelebrant or deacon

will handle the chalice and paten.

- Palm Sunday and Good Friday: One reader may read the readings. The Passion should be read by the deacon or priest (no parts).

- Distribution of Palms: With the order to "stay at home" now in effect through April 13, 2020, the palms

that are blessed on Palm Sunday will be stored for distribution after the "stay at home" order is cancelled.

Please consider suggesting to your parishioners to hang an evergreen branch (or other kind of branch) on

the front door of their homes in a way of being in solidarity for Palm Sunday. Branches could remain throughout Holy Week.

- Good Friday veneration of the cross: It is our desire to do everything we can to support the government

issued orders to remain at home. Therefore, churches will not have crosses displayed for public veneration

this year. Please encourage parishioners to participate through the live-streamed liturgy from the

Cathedral or your own parish live-streamed liturgy. The main celebrant may venerate the cross with a touch, kiss, profound bow or genuflection. Others that are present may venerate with a profound bow or

genuflection while keeping the required social distancing.

- Blessing of the Easter Food Baskets: Blessing of the food baskets is unfortunately cancelled this year due to the "stay at home" order.
