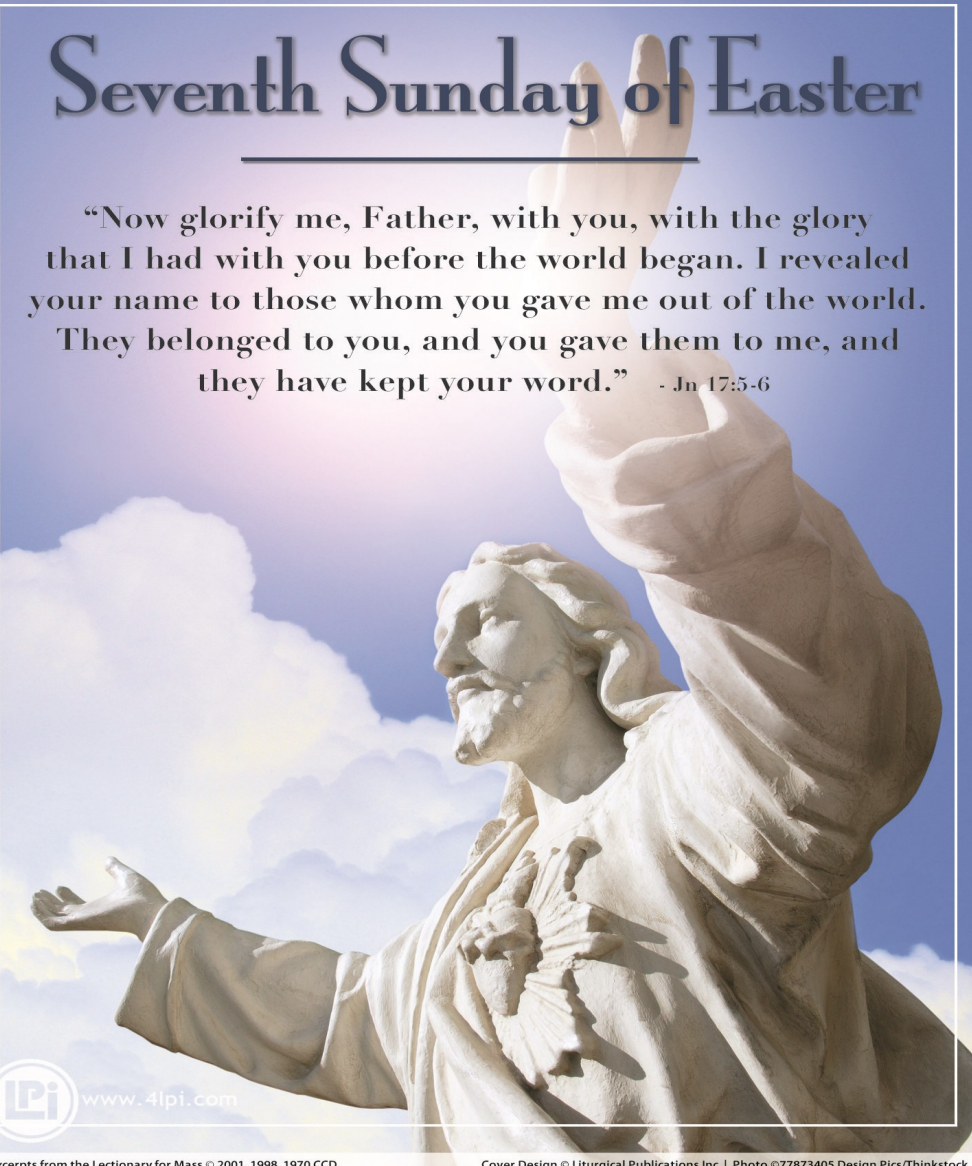

**2020 Census: Your Response Helps Serve Those in Need**

The Catholic Church and other service providers rely on an accurate census to more effectively serve those in need. The U.S. Bishops have called for all to be counted, as society "cannot risk missing this opportunity to give children and parents the tools they need to succeed." Unfortunately, the census has to often undercounted household with young children; with higher rates of poverty, unemployment, or low educational attainment; with racial minorities; and with English as a second language, which leads to underfunding critical programs and services. Make sure you are counted by responding before July 2020.
