





#### MISSION STATEMENT

We, the parishioners of St. Paul, Onaway, open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, are dedicated to preserve, live and proclaim the Good News brought by Jesus. As a sacramental people, we are committed to welcome all into Christ's presence among us.

There is an envelope near the beginning of each set of contributory envelopes that is for Altar Society Dues. The cost is \$2.00 and most all the women of the parish pay those dues and are members. Some gentlemen have used the envelope as well to give a donation.

There are many ways to be an active Altar Society member. The main focus is the Altar environment in all aspects: keeping the furniture polished, wiping the brass candle holders, scraping candle wax after changing the candles, refilling the the five candle stands, washing and ironing all the altar linens, and providing and arranging flowers. The Altar Society purchases all the sacred vessels, vestments and books used for all the Masses, Blessing and Rites.

Moran Iron Works was commissioned to create our two beautiful money box stands. One is for candles, the other for charitable giving. Our most recent purchase was the Baptismal Font. As you can see, the work extends beyond the Altar! The cobwebs that form need constant attention, books need to be placed in the pews in an orderly fashion, holy water fonts need to be cleaned and refilled. Volunteers could, for example say,"I want to take care of stacking the books before the weekend Masses." That task takes about fifteen minutes and is a huge help

Praying the Rosary together, the night before a funeral, provides such comfort to the family of a deceased parishioner. Funeral dinners are another part of ministering to our parish family. The Shawl Ministry evolved from an Altar Society member sharing, at our meeting, what she had seen at her Winter Parish in Florida.

The Christmas Party is organized for the parish by the Altar Society. Decorating and food prep can be divided to lighten the load. The Altar Society also coordinates the desserts for the Knights of Columbus Fish Fries.

We will be scheduling a meeting at a local restaurant in the month of August and would love the social time with more women and fresh new ideas .

A fun time in the kitchen is the Cinnamon Roll Bake! The date is set for November 3rd. Lots of rolls in the freezer for hunting season, Thanksgiving and Christmas!

A few years ago The Altar Society branched out to address the landscape needs. Plants, potting soil, wood chips and planters are some of the items we purchase and with the volunteer help, of guys and gals, care for the church, hall and rectory outdoor
