Dear All,

Below is a general timeline of The Passion of Our Lord. This is as historically accurate as it is possible to be. I share it with you all that you can compare our Parish timings with the events of the last days of the Savior's life. As I mentioned last weekend, the Church wants us to try to experience, as fully as possible, the unfolding of events.

Holy Thursday

Mid-Day – **Jesus’ disciples prepare for the Passover.**
 6:00 p.m. - **Jesus begins the Last Supper.(Mass at St Monica)**
 11:00 p.m. - **Jesus' agony in the Garden at Gethsemane begins. (leaving St Monica following post Mass Adoration.)**
 12:00 a.m. - **Jesus is betrayed by Judas.**

Good Friday

1:00 a.m. - **Jesus before Annas**
 2:00 a.m. - **Jesus before Caiphas**
 6:00 a.m.- **Jesus before Pilate**
 7:00 a.m. - **Jesus before Herod**
 8:00 a.m. - **Jesus is sent back to Pilate.**
 9:00 a.m. - **Jesus is scourged, crowned with thorns, and mocked.**
 11:00 a.m. - **Jesus is making His way to Calvary.**
 12:00 p.m. - **Jesus is nailed to the cross.(Starting at 2pm we are having Stations of the Cross covering all of the above events.)**
 3:00 p.m. - **Jesus dies on the cross.(As the Missal tells us, this service is to begin at 3pm, the beginning of the service of the Lord's passion/Adoration of the Cross.)**
 4:00 p.m. - **Jesus is laid in the sepulchre**

Easter Sunday

Just after sunrise Jesus rose from the dead. (6:30am, sunrise Mass @ St Monica)
 (In the past the Easter Vigil would be going from sunset to sunrise.)

May you all have a Blessed Easter and a Joyful Eastertide.

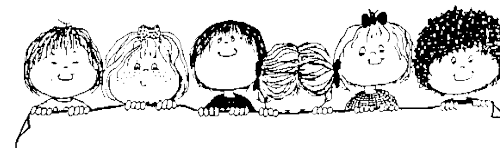
