

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for showing interest in deepening your faith through the education of your children.

This, of course, should be the minimum. Your involvement in Parish Life is extremely important. Activities, adoration and weekday and evening mass are all things that you should be actively considering.

I have been told that for many sports participation gets in the way of practicing the faith. To be very clear, no sport activity is going to help your child get to heaven. This should be a very simple choice.

#### **FAITH FORMATION**

We have begun registration for children for Faith Formation. The packets are available for **COLLECTION** from the parish office. There is a cost for each child. We require to do this to cover our increasing overheads.

**Registration is necessary before the first day of class.** Failure to do so may result in your child not being able to participate.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

You and your child need to attend BOTH mass and class every weekend. Failure to miss either for three times will resort in your child failing the program.

If this seems unreasonable feel free to make an appointment with me to discuss this.

Attendance at MASS is not a suggestion. It is a precept of the church.

#### Finally in the catechism of the Church

Article #2223, under the section "DUTIES OF THE PARENT", it states "Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children" and "Parents have a grave responsibility to give good example to their children"

Article #2226 "Family Catechesis precedes, accompanies, and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith."

It is your job to teach the faith. Do not enter this lightly. Look at this as an opportunity to enrich your life by learning what GOD intends for you and your child.

We look forward to helping you to teach your children the FAITH.
